## PUBLIC NOTICE Waller Solar I, LLC

The Waller Solar Facility, an approximately 131 MWac solar photovoltaic generating facility, is proposed to be located in Lancaster County, Virginia. The project is designed to consist of approximately 320,000 photovoltaic bi-facial solar panels that will primarily be affixed to a single-axis tracking system that is able to alter direction for optimal solar exposure; however, the project may also utilize panels attached to a fixed-tilt racking system. The panels will have a maximum height of 15 feet. The project is proposed on an approximate 2,674-acre site located on privately-owned land in northern Lancaster County, on the east and west sides of State Route 3 between White Chapel Road and the boundary with Richmond County.

Waller Solar I, LLC invites the public to learn more about this project by attending the public meeting or contacting our team. Waller Solar I, LLC seeks to (i) acquaint the public with the technical aspects of the proposed project and how the standards and requirements of the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) Small Renewable Energy Projects (Solar) Permit by Rule (PBR) regulations will be met, (ii) identify issues of concern, (iii) facilitate communication, and (iv) establish a dialogue with persons who may be affected by the project.

In accordance with 9VAC15-60-90 C, a 30-day comment period will be held November 25, 2022 through December 25, 2022. A public meeting will be held in accordance with 9VAC15-60-90 D on December 14, 2022, from 5:00-7:00 pm at the Upper Lancaster Volunteer Fire Department, located at 4508 Mary Ball Road, Lancaster, VA 22503. This public meeting will be held as an open house format, with display panels provided and company representatives present to answer questions. There is no scheduled presentation.

Copies of the documentation to be submitted to the DEQ in support of the Permit by Rule application will be available for inspection at the Lancaster Community Library, located at 16 Town Centre Drive, Kilmarnock, VA 22482. During the comment period, materials will be available for public viewing Monday through Thursday from 10:00am - 8:00pm and Friday and Saturday from 10:00am - 5:00pm.
